




Aquarius 20 Jan – 18 Feb



Bars on the Head line lead to Tension

Bars across the head line are a sign that big decisions need to be made that effect the entire direction of life, or that others are interfering in your own decision making process.

What's that in the sky?

To be amazed by the heavens, first get your bearings and note that the sun rises in the east, sets in the west and the warmest side of the house is north. ☺

For all you night owls

Jupiter is in pride of place high in the night sky. On the 10th March he will be together with the Moon and they will make a magnificent sight. I would make a wish on those two! The Saucepan is above Jupiter but see if you can imagine it as the sword and belt of Orion the great hero of the heavens.

The eye of the bull, Aldebaran and his heart, the glittering Seven Sisters, also known as the Pleiades are to Jupiter's lower left (east.).

If you are up late you will see Mars rise in the east. Let the Moon be your guide when she passes by him on the 18th and 19th. And if you are up really late you will see Saturn rise in the east. He will be with the Moon on the 21st. The Southern Cross is high above the two pointer stars.

If you are up later than really late, then you are either partying, have a baby or its shift work. I have done all three; just in different decades! Whatever the reason, look up and enjoy.

For all you early birds

Venus is our brilliant morning star shining in the east. Mercury will appear very low on the horizon make a fleeting visit (as is his nature) in the first half of the month. Saturn is high overhead and Mars further to the west.

The Scorpion is chasing Saturn with the bright star Antares clearly visible. If it weren't so darn early I would be out every clear morning just to say hello.

Let the Moon be your guide as she passes by Mars on the 19th and 20th, then passes Saturn on the 21st and 22nd. Finally she passes Venus on the 28th March. Turn around to see the Southern Cross below the two bright pointer stars.

Let yourself be awed!

Autumn Equinox is on the 21st March

At the equinox the Sun is directly overhead at the equator. It will rise nearly due east and set due west. That means that both the northern and southern hemispheres get an equal amount of night and daylight hours. Equinox means equal.
