
### **Capricorn** 22 Dec – 19 Jan

**Leo** 23 July 22 Aug


*"When we are alive, we are warm. When we are dead, we are cold.*

## News from the Stars July 2018

Mars stays in Aquarius retrograde

Saturn stays retrograde in Capricorn

10<sup>th</sup> July Venus enters Virgo

11<sup>th</sup> July Jupiter turns direct in Scorpio

13<sup>th</sup> July **New Moon** in Cancer with partial Solar Eclipse in Cancer visible in Southern VIC and SA

23<sup>rd</sup> July Sun enters Leo

26<sup>th</sup> July Mercury turns retrograde in Leo

28<sup>th</sup> July **Full Moon** in Aquarius with total Lunar Eclipse only visible here as the Moon sets



The movement of the planets herald time when we feel mood changes, times we are galvanized to take action, and others times when we lack energy. There are shifts in feelings and energy levels at all New and Full Moons, when planets move into signs, or when there are connections (aspects) between planets, or when they turn retrograde or move direct again.

Pay attention to the days when these shifts happen and notice your feelings and energy levels. This understanding will enhance your experience of life.

To further experience the rhythm of the Moon I suggest that you aim to start planning new projects and events at the New Moon, initiate them the day after the New Moon and bring them to full development approximately two weeks later at the Full Moon. From the Full Moon back to the New Moon is a time to look at the consequences, to reflect on what you achieved and to think about changes or new ideas that you will “birth” again at the New Moon.

Enjoy the ride!

## What's that in the sky? July 2018

To be amazed by the heavens, first get your bearings and note that North is the warmest side of the house. Face north and on your right is the east where the Sun rises, and on your left is west where the sun sets. Behind you is south. The darkest night is on the New Moon on the 13<sup>th</sup> July and the brightest night is with the Full Moon on the 28<sup>th</sup> July.

### For all you Night Owls

A beautiful sight awaits you tonight with Venus the Evening star shining in the west and close to the bright star Regulus in the heart of Leo the Lion. Mercury is lower and practically sitting on the horizon at sunset. Find yourself handy hill or high spot and watch the place where the sun disappears.... you will see one of those faint stars moving over the

other faint stars and golly yes, you have found Mercury. I still remember the excitement that I felt the first time I found him. It's a bit like seeing magic.

Jupiter is overhead to the north and a big hand span to the right is Antares, in the eye of the Scorpion who always keeps us company over winter. Follow the line of stars to see the gigantic twist and curve of his tail. Saturn is high in the east and all the way to the eastern horizon is Mars.

Yes, it's a busy night with two planets to the left of us, two planets to the right and a planet overhead!

Let the Moon be your guide when she is with Mercury on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, with Venus on the 16<sup>th</sup>, with Jupiter on the 21<sup>st</sup>, with Saturn on the 25<sup>th</sup> and with Mars on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>.

Turn around to see the Southern Cross the right way up with the Pointer Stars clear and bright, pointing the way. Even the heavens want you to see it clearly!

Remember that we are the ones doing the moving and the sun does not set... we roll away from him!

The Sun does not rise... we roll towards him. Thinking about it feels weird but allowing yourself to feel the motion will enhance your viewpoint of this wonderful planet we live on.

### **For all you Early Birds**

Early this month on the 1<sup>st</sup> and again the 28<sup>th</sup> July you will see the Moon below Mars in the north-west. Lower in the west is Saturn but he will be gone within a few days and will become clearly visible in the evening. The Southern Cross is in the south, yep, that's why they called it the Southern Cross. Anyhow, the Cross is upside down and very low in the sky and the Pointer Stars have their work cut pointing the way as even they are low to the right. Go back to bed or continue on your way to work and have a great day. **Let yourself be amazed.**
