

This Month's News from the Stars

What's that Star in the sky this September?

To be amazed by the heavens, first get your bearings and note that North is the warmest side of the house. Face north and on your right is the east where the Sun rises, and on your left is west where the sun sets. Behind you is south. The darkest night is with the New Moon on the 10th September and the brightest night is with the Full Moon on the 25th September.

For all you Night Owls

This is a wonderful month for star gazers! Venus is low on the west and very close to the fixed star Spica. Above her is Jupiter, nearby is Antares in the eye of the Scorpion, and high above is Saturn and a little further over to the east is Mars. Let the Moon be your guide when she is below Venus on the 12th and 13th Sep. Then she will be below Jupiter on the 14th, below Antares on the 15th, below Saturn on the 17th and close to Mars on the 20th September. As I said... lots to see! To top it off, turn around to the south to see the Pointer Stars high in the south, politely pointing at the Southern Cross lying on its side below them.

For all you Early Birds

Go back to bed as no planets are visible and its probably cold. For those who have to be up, look directly ahead to see Aldebaran in the eye of Taurus the bull and below is the star cluster called the 7 Sisters, also known as the Pleiades, in his heart. Let the Moon be your guide when she is between Aldebaran and the Pleiades on the 3rd September. Orion is high overhead and to see him you have to imagine the Saucepan as a belt with a dangling sword and imagine it all upside down! Turn south to see the Southern Cross low and nearly upside down with the Pointer Stars low to the right. Go out and have a look at the sun and ponder on the fact that we are the ones that is moving and the sun does not set... we roll away from him! The Sun does not rise... we roll towards him. Think about it and let yourself be amazed.



Father's Day is on the 2nd September

This is an idea I saw somewhere else and it's a good one... so I always suggest.... ask your dad if you can... "what advice can you share about life, happiness and money? What does being a dad mean to you? What are you most proud of? How would you like to be remembered?"

I hope that thinking about these questions helps you form an idea of what you want for yourself as a parent.

Spring Equinox on the 23rd September

Known as the celebration of Ostara, at the equinox the Sun is directly overhead at the equator. It will rise due east and set due west. That means that both the northern and southern hemispheres get an equal amount of night and daylight hours. The ancients knew that the sun's light has overcome the winter darkness and they knew that food

would be growing, and that they had survived the long winter. Even for us with handy supermarkets scattered around.... the coming of Spring still feels good!

Chinese Moon Festival on 24th September

This festival is one of the most important events in the Chinese year after the Chinese New Year. It is known as the Mid-Autumn Festival, (spring here in the Southern Hemisphere) and is celebrated on the 15th day of the eighth lunar month since 1600 BCE and celebrates the Moon Goddess. And as you can imagine... I love this idea! 😊

It is also called the Mooncake festival after the traditional cake of the festival. It involves thanksgiving, family gathering and praying for a loved one. It is said that when circumstances prevent couples from getting together during the event, they pass the night by watching the moon at the same time... so it seems as if they are together for the night.
